- Thunderstorms frequently produce strong downward rushes of air, called microbursts that spread out along the ground generating areas of dense blowing dust or haboobs
- Do NOT drive into a dust storm
- If do you become caught up in a dust storm, don't run into another vehicle, but do make your vehicle less likely to get hit:
 - 1) Pull off the road, put vehicle in park
 - 2) Turn off lights
 - 3) Take your foot off the brake pedal, keep seat belt on
